Leader and Apprentice Responsibilities

Gospel Community *Leader* Responsibilities

1. Complete the Missional Leadership Training video series (YouTube).
2. Prayerfully plan how to live into gospel rhythms **monthly** using the planning guide.
3. Dialogue with those in your Gospel Community about living into gospel rhythms.
4. Prayerfully help the Gospel Community discern their unique **missional calling**.
5. Seek to help those in your Gospel Community identify/use their **Trinitarian Gift Mix**.
6. Seek to live a life of integrity to the gospel in weakness and humble dependence.
7. Shepherd/lovingly care for (with the input of your coach or an elder) those a part of your GC and in your neighborhood/relational network.
8. When issues arise personally or communally, seek out your Gospel Community coach for prayerful dialogue and counsel. If necessary, the coach may include a GR elder.
9. Consistently invite Gospel Community participants into **Fight Clubs** relationally.
10. Consistently invite Gospel Community participants into deeper relationship with you and your neighbors/relational network (Gospel Community = primary relationships).
11. Faithfully participate in **Gospel Community** leadership gatherings.
12. Faithfully prepare and engage in **quarterly** Gospel Community coaching gatherings.
13. Ask God to identify a Gospel Community Apprentice and invest in them relationally with intentionality and purpose.
14. Seek to multiply Gospel Communities in different neighborhoods as God directs.

Gospel Community *Apprentice* Responsibilities
